Humboldt State University has identified two key programming components of the Behavioral & Social Sciences Building that must be satisfied in each proposal. Please add the following paragraph, complete, to the "SCOPE OF WORK INCLUSIONS" section beginning on page one (1) of the RFP dated February 17, 2011:

- The design builder shall provide for the following specific program components to accommodate the needs of the Psychology Department and the California State University Center for American Indian Studies:
 - A. Psychology Department: 21,860 ASF
 - 1. Provide 23 offices for faculty including standard physical and utility features each office to be 110 ASF.
 - 2. Provide 1,400 ASF of Clerical/Storage space.
 - 3. Provide one (1) Group Dynamics teaching lab (720 ASF) with adjoining observation room (240 ASF). Observation room shall have one common wall with Group Dynamics Lab featuring a one-way mirror.
 - 4. Provide six (6) individual interview rooms (180 ASF each) connected to one (1) General Observation Room. Each interview room shall share one common wall with the General Observation Room and feature a one way mirror. Each interview room shall have no exterior windows and shall not directly connect to the General Observation Room.
 - 5. Provide three (3) individual research labs (500 ASF) with adjoining observation rooms sharing one common wall with one-way mirror.
 - 6. Provide the following rooms for support of graduate research:
 - *i.* Rat Colony Quarters (400 ASF)
 - *ii.* Chicken Colony Quarters (400 ASF)
 - *iii.* Histology (Animal Examination) Facility (500 ASF)
 - 7. Remaining space to be designed to accommodate Graduate level research laboratories, group therapy rooms, lobby and waiting areas and a small psychology clinic.



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- B. California State University Center for American Indian Studies: 9,000 ASF
 - 1. Provide three (3) offices of 150 ASF. Two (2) of these offices to be connected such that one office is the reception space for the second office.
 - 2. Provide one (1) Gallery of American Indian Art (3,600 ASF) with adjoining preparation space (1,200 ASF).
 - 3. Provide one (1) 3,000 ASF Intercultural Communications Forum (conference center) employing architectural elements to symbolize The California State University's commitment to American Indians and their values. The design should be a circular or octagonal tiered floor with a round skylight above the center of the chamber. The main entrance will be diagonally opposite from the stage, which will have a small exit behind it. It will require full audio and visual equipment and a projection booth.
 - 4. Provide one (1) 1,200 storage space for equipment and art not being displayed or in use at the center.
