The Hall of Justice Project Site is bordered by Aliso Avenue and US Highway 101 to the north, Spring Street and the Federal Courthouse to the east, Temple Street and the Criminal Courts building to the south and Broadway Street and the County Civic Center Cogeneration Facility to the west.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING?

The County of Los Angeles is seeking approval to allow the renovation and reoccupation of the Hall of Justice on the existing Hall of Justice site.

The County of Los Angeles will be preparing an Environmental Impact Report (EIR), pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, to assess the potential environmental impacts of this project. Additionally, pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act, the Federal Emergency Management Agency will be preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA). As part of this process, these public meetings are being held to solicit comments from people in the area concerning the potential environmental effects of the proposed project on the community.

Comments made at these meetings will be considered in determining the topics to be studied in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Environmental Assessment (EA).

WHAT IS PROPOSED?

The County of Los Angeles is proposing to renovate the Hall of Justice (HOJ) for use by the County Sheriff's Department, District Attorney and other County agencies. The primary objective of the project is to rehabilitate and reuse the HOJ by seismically retrofitting the earthquake damaged building and refurbishing the building interior for modern office use while preserving its historic features to the extent preservation is economically feasible. The renovation and restoration of exterior elements of the building are also proposed. The building was used for jail, court and office purposes until closed in 1994.

Twin Blasts in Israel Kill 23, Injure Scores

Many victims of the suicide bombings are foreign workers. Some who fled the first explosion ran headlong into the second.

TEL AVIV - A working-class neighborhood here thronged with foreign laborers just knocking off for the day when two suicide bombers, a street apart, detonated their deadly loads within two minutes of each other at dusk Sunday.

Including the bombers, 25 people were killed and more than 100 injured by the twin blasts, which shook two parallel streets in the Neve Shaanan district, a seedy neighborhood of bars, brothels and cash exchanges. The rush-hour carnage marked the most devastating such attack since 20 people died in a Passover bombing in March at a coastal hotel near Tel Aviv."

The attack came just three weeks before Israeli elections in which one of the dividing lines between the Likud Party candidate, Prime Minister Ariel Sharon, and Amram Mitzna of proaches to dealing with the Palthe two explosions were foreign ers, but many of the injured were from overseas, according to police spokesman Gil Kleiman.

In early evening, the neighborhood's narrow streets are usually crowded with Filipino, Vietnamese, Ghanalan and Chinese workers, many of them illegal inumigrants, as well as bluecollar Israelis looking to relax with a beer, pick up a woman or catch a bus home.


It was about 6:30 p.m. when the first bomb exploded in front of a bus stop. Some panicked bystanders scrambled away, only to run headlong into shrapnel from the second blast. The later bomb blew up outside Checkpoint, a currency exchange where foreign workers had lined [See Israel, Page A8]


