STONE TOILET COMPARTMENTS

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 DESCRIPTION

- A. This Section describes the requirements for furnishing and installing floor-mounted marble toilet compartments with stile and rail wood doors.
- B. Related Sections:
 - 1. Stile and rail wood doors are specified in Section 08 14 33.
 - 2. Toilet compartments are specified in Section 10 21 13.
 - 3. Toilet accessories are specified in Section 10 28 13.

1.02 SUBMITTALS

- A. Product Data; Manufacturer's technical data for materials, fabrication, and installation, include catalog cuts of anchors, hardware, fastenings, and accessories.
- B. Shop Drawings: Furnish for fabrication and erection of assemblies not fully described by product drawings, templates, and installation instructions.
- C. Samples: Full range of color samples for each type of unit required. Furnish 6-inch square samples of each color and finish on same substrate to be used in the work, for color verification after selections have been made.

1.03 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Field Measurements: Take field measurements prior to preparation of Shop Drawings and fabrication where possible. Allow for adjustments within specified tolerances wherever taking field measurements before fabrication might delay the work.
- B. Coordination: Furnish inserts and anchors to be built into other work; coordinate delivery to avoid delay.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.01 MATERIALS

- A. Marble: Georgia Marble Company, color and pattern to match the historic toilet partitions of the Hall of Justice, polished finish.
- B. Stile and Rail Wood Doors: To match those at the Hall of Justice, as specified in Section 08 14 33.
- C. Door Hardware: Doors shall be fitted with gravity-type top and bottom hinges, door strike, side-bar latch, door pull, coat hook, and bumper, finished in chrome plating.
- D. Miscellaneous Hardware: Compartments shall be fitted with chrome-plated brass clip angles fastened with theft-resistant spanner heads and threaded brass rods.
- E. Fasteners: Stainless steel, theft-proof type.
- F. Stone Cleaner: HMK Stone Care S34 Silicone impregnator.
- G. Stone Sealer: HMK Stone Care R55 intensive cleaner/grout film remover, acid free.

2.02 FABRICATION

A. General: Provide stile and rail wood doors and polished marble panels, screens, and pilasters. Furnish units with cutouts and drilled holes to receive partition-mounted hardware, accessories, and grab bars, as indicated. Panels and doors shall be 1-inch thick; pilasters shall be 1-1/4-inch thick.

B. Door Dimensions: Unless otherwise indicated, provide 24-inch wide in-swinging doors for regular stalls and 34-inch wide clear opening out-swinging doors at stalls equipped for use by the handicapped.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.01 INSTALLATION

A. General:

- 1. Comply with manufacturer's recommended procedures and installation sequence.
- 2. Install partitions rigid, straight, plumb, and level.
- 3. Provide clearances of not more than 1/2-inch between pilasters and panels, and not more than 1-inch between panels and walls.
- 4. Secure panels to walls with not less than two stirrup brackets attached near top and bottom of panel.
- 5. Locate wall brackets so that holes for wall anchors occur in masonry or tile joints.
- 6. Secure panels to pilasters with not less than two stirrup brackets located to align with stirrup brackets at wall.

B. Floor-Supported Compartments:

- 1. Set pilaster units with anchors having not less than 2-inch penetration into structural floor, unless otherwise recommended by partition manufacturer.
- 2. Level, plumb, and tighten installation.
- 3. Hang doors and adjust so that tops of doors are level with tops of pilasters when doors are in closed position.

3.02 ADJUST AND CLEAN

- A. Hardware Adjustment:
 - 1. Adjust and lubricate hardware for proper operation.
 - Set hinges on in-swinging doors to hold doors open approximately 30-degrees from closed position when unlatched.
 - 3. Set hinges on out-swinging doors and entrance swing doors to return to fully closed position.
- B. Clean marble surfaces to remove dirt and stains. Do not use wire brushes, harsh abrasive cleaners, or acid.
- C. Apply two coats of sealer to exposed marble in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
