This memorandum is issued to address a question regarding the preparation and submittal of the Prequalification Statement identified in the December 20, 2007 invitation.

Question 1:

I received an e-mail from Skanska with an outline for the LEED competition and a deadline for a pre-proposal of late January (24th-ish), but there is a line in the letter stating that submissions will be reviewed to determine if the group will be allowed to continue with the competition. I need to make travel plans for our team and want clarification regarding how the process will work.

Response 1:

The specific language in question is: "In preparation for the competition, the selection committee requests that your team submit the Prequalification Statement detailed above by January 24, 2008, 2pm Pacific Standard Time to dan.haas@skanska.com in order to be considered for further proposal selection."

Submittal of the Prequalification Statement is required for all teams planning to participate in the problem statement. The Prequalification Statements will be graded as part of the response to problem statement. **Failure** to submit the Prequalification Statement will render the overall proposal non-responsive and **disqualify** a team from participation in the problem statement.

If a registered team provides the Prequalification Statement they will be allowed to participate in the problem.

Please note the due date and time is not an "-ish" deadline.
