

Visual Arts

It is the goal of the visual arts program to increase students' skills, knowledge and appreciation of the visual arts. All 3 art labs should allow for multi-use for the visual arts discipline: 3-dimensional, 2-dimensional, and Graphic/Electronic Arts as well as traditional teaching of art appreciation and art history. All spaces should accommodate an "art portrait" area, i.e., photography, creating digital prints, and portfolios. There should be appropriate technology for completing 3-dimensional projects, doing virtual art museum tours and other design work.

The pages that follow contain a list of spaces and drawings illustrating the relationship between various program areas and the individual spaces within the program area. Additionally, a description of the activities, persons to accommodate, and items to be considered is included.


