

# DEWEYVILLE TRAILHEAD TO NECK LAKE ROAD PROJECT

1. From the airport go to the main highway.
2. Turn right for the market/fuel, turn left for the jobsite.
3. Drive for approximately 20 minutes to Control Lake Junction (see picture below). Turn Left.



4. Proceed for approximately 10.6 miles to milepost 27.8 at the detour sign. Turn left onto the dirt road Detour (see picture below).



5. Drive detour road for approximately 30 minutes. You will arrive back to the main roadway on SE Roadbuilders jobsite. Take a left to continue on the alignment.
6. Proceed up the roadway. You will pass public bathrooms on your right at Sarkar Lake and cross "Sarkar Rapids Creek" bridge. Next you will see "Deweyville Trailhead". This is the start of Kiewit's alignment.
7. Continue for three miles to MP 85. You will see a large quantity of shot rock stockpiled just outside the office site. Take a left up the rock roadway to enter the office site.
8. Watch for haul trucks, equipment, public traffic and deer. Back into your parking spot. Honk three times prior to backing up. Honk twice when moving forward. Immediately check in with a Kiewit employee on site and ask for PPE.
