The Emeryville MOB is planned to support an integrated model for healthcare practices. The medical office building will contain three operating rooms, two minor procedures rooms (for endoscopy and minor procedures), one MRI, one CT, blood draw with a small laboratory, nuclear medicine, non-retail pharmacy, mammography, minor imagining (flat plate X-Ray) and clinical exam areas for primary and specialty care including ENT, Gastroenterology, urology, vascular, neurology, pulmonology and pre-anesthesia clinics. Direct access to the community will enhance the patient experience and create opportunities for community members to receive care locally.
