RE: Addendum #4 - Historical Artifact

The University's Archeologist would like Design-Builders to incorporate Native American history into the design of the proposed building. During construction of the surrounding buildings, historical artifacts were found and are believed to be used by Native American tribes who lived on the site land hundreds of years ago. The University is notifying all proposing Design-Builders that they should provide provisions in the schedule to accommodate the possible discovery of an artifact. The University will preserve the artifact for display within the newly constructed Student Success Center. The Design-Builder shall assume that the monument will be provided by the University.

Deliverables:

- Integrate the following into the project schedule:
 - A 3-day activity during excavation for artifact monitoring.
 - A 1-day stand-down activity at the end of excavation to honor the tribe who lived on this land.
- Include a single Allowance line item in the overall budget for \$5,000 to install the monument.
- Show the proposed location for the monument in the design of the building. The monument will require a 5' \times 5' space.
