

## **Appendix H: Festival of Flight**

Long Beach airport is hosting their annual Festival of Flight where thousands of attendees are expected at the airport to witness aircraft on static display and in the air, live music, activities for kids, food & beer trucks, and helicopter rides.

As this is an annual event, this will occur twice during project construction: on October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024 and October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

Long Beach Airport starts preparing the site for this event one month before the day of the event, meaning all construction work must move to night work beginning (30) calendar days before the event, and no work of any kind may take place during the (5) calendar days leading up to the event. All work to return to it's regularly schedule time beginning the Monday after the event.
