A MESSAGE TO THE ASC STUDENT COMPETITORS:

The 36th Annual Associated Schools of Construction (ASC) Regions 6 & 7 Student Competition is host to the largest construction management student competition in the nation. This year over 1,600 students competing on 218 teams coming from 57 universities and 25 states are ready to compete. The 17 problem sponsoring companies have worked hard to provide all competing teams with a challenging and educational experience. Whenever possible, take the opportunity to thank them for their efforts and support of the ASC.

The competition aspect of our event must be fair. No student or team should have an unfair advantage. It is expected that your team is prepared, rehearsed, and that you have researched the industry for helpful information. However, in the event that you were professionally involved with or have specific knowledge of the actual problem issued by the sponsor that is beyond “public knowledge”, you must immediately notify your sponsor of a possible conflict of interest. Follow the rules, and remember only six team members can materially participate in the solution of the problem. There are no “runners” or individuals that may assist the team for any reason other than safety issues. For the entire duration of the competition, Thursday and Friday, there must be no contact with anyone that is not a member of your team (alternates, fellow students, industry, faculty, or coaches) until your team has presented. After presenting take time to thank everyone who helped you get to this point and assisted in your achievement.

Every detail of this year’s competition has been planned and organized to be a memorable and rewarding experience. The problem sponsors are ready, teams are ready, and the Nugget is ready to make this year’s competition a great event. Familiarize yourself with the hotel floor plan and locate your problem sponsor’s presentation room, study the event schedule, and do your part to contribute positively to your team’s effort and to the ASC.

You can find the list of times and locations for all of the week’s planned events inside this program. The Welcome Dinner begins at 6:00 p.m. in the Nugget Grand Ballroom. The competition kicks off with the Team Jump Start which begins Thursday morning at 5:00 AM in Nugget 1 and ends with a Job Fair and Awards Ceremonies on Saturday.

Be sure to identify and thank, whenever you have the opportunity, all of the sponsors that have generously supported these and the many other events happening this week. 



Life Changing

Randy Lorge is the director of Workforce Training and Development for the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials (IAPMO) and a master plumber by trade. IAPMO coordinates the development and adaptation of uniform plumbing, mechanical, swimming pool and solar energy codes to meet the specific needs of individual jurisdictions in the United States and abroad.

IAPMO provides leadership toward addressing the global need for sound water efficiency-based codes and standards while working to avoid unintended consequences that have the potential to compromise health and safety. IAPMO supports science-based research and policy-based initiatives at all levels of government, with the goal of helping provide for the safe use of water in buildings around the world. Randy also serves as the International Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (IWSH) Foundation's North American program director.

Randy Lorge, IAPMO

Through IWSH, Randy has worked across the Navajo Nation installing safe water and sanitation systems since 2018. This past year, the Navajo Technical University (NTU) started a 34-credit plumbing certificate program for which Randy wrote the curriculum, and he coordinated and developed a hands-on training lab. His IWSH team is working on a project in the Black Belt region of Lowndes County, Alabama, where hundreds of homes straight pipe their raw sewage into their backyards. Randy has also traveled to India, South Africa, and Indonesia, where he designed and installed plumbing systems.

Randy will talk about how he started in the plumbing industry 30 years ago as a third-generation plumber and share how his career has evolved from installer to educator and, finally, humanitarian. His focus will highlight how everyone has the ability to change lives. Randy will share personal stories of how his experiences have changed him not only as plumber, but as a teacher, father, husband, and the person he is today.

Randy's message: We are not meant to be average; we are meant to be our best.



	Implementation of a Time Management Training Module in an Entry Level Construction Management Course The transition to a four-year University presents a host of new challenges for first-year students. These students are thrust into a situation where they are solely responsible for balancing a variety of responsibilities, ranging from attending classes, completing outside classwork, and addressing personal and social obligations. Not surprisingly, the first-year of college is the most critical timeframe in determining whether a student will persist at a four-year University. Approximately 18% of freshmen students will either change schools or dropout out of their University during the first year. Effective time management skills demonstrate improved academic performance and lower stress and anxiety in students, thus increasing the likelihood students will persist. Unfortunately, time management skills are rarely taught, and it's expected students learn these skills on their own. In this presentation the author will demonstrate how a time management training was implemented in a first-year Construction Management (CMGT) course. The objective of this implementation was to assess whether time management skills can be effectively taught to first-year students, resulting in improvement in student behavior, performance and reduced stress levels.


