A MESSAGE TO THE ASC STUDENT COMPETITORS:

The 37th Annual Associated Schools of Construction (ASC) Regions 6 & 7 Student Competition is host to the largest construction management student competition in the nation. This year over 1,700 students competing on 233 teams coming from 54 universities and 25 states are ready to compete. The 17 problem sponsoring companies have worked hard to provide all competing teams with a challenging and educational experience. Whenever possible, take the opportunity to thank them for their efforts and support of the ASC.

The competition aspect of our event must be fair. No student or team should have an unfair advantage. It is expected that your team is prepared, rehearsed, and that you have researched the industry for helpful information. However, in the event that you were professionally involved with or have specific knowledge of the actual problem issued by the sponsor that is beyond “public knowledge”, you must immediately notify your sponsor of a possible conflict of interest. Follow the rules, and remember only six team members can materially participate in the solution of the problem. There are no “runners” or individuals that may assist the team for any reason other than safety issues. For the entire duration of the competition, Thursday and Friday, there must be no contact with anyone that is not a member of your team (alternates, fellow students, industry, faculty, or coaches) until your team has presented. After presenting take time to thank everyone who helped you get to this point and assisted in your achievement.

Every detail of this year’s competition has been planned and organized to be a memorable and rewarding experience. The problem sponsors are ready, teams are ready, and the Nugget is ready to make this year’s competition a great event. Familiarize yourself with the hotel floor plan and locate your problem sponsor’s presentation room, study the event schedule, and do your part to contribute positively to your team’s effort and to the ASC.

You can find the list of times and locations for all of the week’s planned events inside this program. The Welcome Dinner begins at 6:00 p.m. in the Nugget Grand Ballroom. The competition kicks off with the Team Jump Start which begins Thursday morning at 5:00 AM in Nugget 1 and ends with a Job Fair and Awards Ceremonies on Saturday.

Be sure to identify and thank, whenever you have the opportunity, all of the sponsors that have generously supported these and the many other events happening this week. The sponsors and job fair participants are the ones that have provided the financial support to help make this event special and have partnered with the ASC to continue to enhance construction education. Your university construction programs have also invested in your success and their commitment to the ASC is reflected in your accomplishments.



Competition Code of Conduct for All Attendees

** August 18, 2023 **

The Associated Schools of Construction Regions 6 & 7 Student Competition is committed to creating an environment that exemplifies the core values of honesty, integrity, and respect for all participants, including students, faculty, industry representatives, and our venue staff and vendors. In particular, the value of mutual responsibility, demonstrated by not standing by while others are being harmed is fundamental to the competition experience.

We are committed to creating a productive, respectful, harassment-free environment for all participants. Harassment, as outlined below is considered to be a serious form of professional misconduct.

This Code of Conduct is established in order to promote safety and respect in all of our activities. We expect all participants to abide by this policy in all venues, including ancillary events and unofficial social gatherings:

- Exercise consideration and respect in your speech and actions;
- Refrain from demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behavior and speech;
- Be mindful of your surroundings and of your fellow participants;
- Alert competition leadership if you notice a dangerous situation, someone in distress, or violations of this policy, even if they seem minor.

The following behaviors do not belong at the ASC Regions 6 & 7 Student Competition:

1. Sexual harassment of any kind, including unwelcome sexual attention and inappropriate physical contact;
2. Harassment that discriminates against a specific group of people based on age, race, sex, ethnicity, national origin, religion, language, sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression, disability, health conditions, socioeconomic status, marital status, or parental status (hereafter, simply harassment);
3. Abuse of power (including abuses related to position, wealth, race, or gender).

ASC's commitment



Nugget Casino Resort Floor Plans



Drilling for a Miracle

On August 5th, 2010, the San Jose gold and copper mine in Copiapó, Chile collapsed, trapping 33 men, 2300 feet below ground surface. Jeff Hart led the “Plan B” drill team, tasked with drilling a 28” diameter shaft into the mine that would allow a capsule to be lowered for the rescue of the miners.

The incident captured the attention of the entire world and is a story of innovation, dedication, and survival.

Life and Career

American drilling expert Jeff Hart became internationally famous in 2010 after helping rescue 33 Chilean miners who had been trapped underground for nearly two months.

Born in 1970, grew up in the San Luis Valley in Southern Colorado, and attended school in Phoenix for Electro-Mechanical Design degree. Jeff Hart entered the professional world as an American hard-rock driller; a well-regarded expert in the subtle art of drilling deep shafts into the earth to create wells for water, minerals and energy. Hart lives outside of Denver, Colorado with his wife and has two sons. Hart is currently the Sr. Operations Manager for the Water Resource Division of Layne-A Granite Company.



<p>What can be some integration points for Lean in the Design and Construction Curriculum?</p> <p>Lean has been practiced by the design and construction industry for over a decade, still, it is not a part of the mainstream curriculum, aligned to the various student learning outcomes. This is the first gap. Additionally, many design and construction organizations, are members of the Lean Construction Institute community and represent the methods and practices that form the corresponding body of knowledge for the Lean implementation. This community produces many resources that can be used for Lean education and training in universities. However, academia is not always aware of the learning resources being produced by the LCI member community. This is the second gap. Therefore, this project aimed to identify integration points for Lean in the design and construction curriculum by mapping the existing LCI’s learning resources to their respective student learning outcomes (SLOs).
